Agile techniques such as eXtreme Programming, Scrum and Lean Software Development are becoming increasingly mainstream. They describe how to successfully deliver projects in complex situations, when requirements and possible solutions are subject to continuous change. However they also stop short of describing a full project lifecycle with defined phases.

The end result meets with your current customer need and is delivered with minimal cost, waste and time, enabling business to achieve bottom line gains earlier than many more traditional approaches.
