

## ISO/IEC 27001:2013 Lead Auditor

### OVERVIEW

This course covers everything that both an auditor and lead auditor need to know. Delegates may choose to take the lead auditor course rather than the implementer course, as it provides the knowledge of how an ISO 27001 implementation should be structured, plus the skills required for an internal auditor, along with a solid view of what an external auditor will be looking for.
